INFRASTRUCTURE NEWS

Boy, were we surprised when we received notice that we were receiving our grant money for manganese and copper mitigation after all!

We are still very early on in the process. Permitting, contracting and other behind the scenes work is in the offing now. On-site work will not start for several months. We estimate the project to be completed sometime in the summer of 2027.

The work you see happening in the well yard right now is Quality Water cleaning and applying epoxy inside and out, repairing cracks that could lead to water contamination, and will be installing a new hatch and railing. They will also hook up a new hydrant for fire suppression. Fortunately, we made it through the winter without a catastrophe. When this project and the grant work are complete, we will no longer need to be concerned with running out of clean, crystal clear water when there is a power outage.



Board Updates

We are looking into the possibility of selling the lot that the association owns due south and west of the well yard to give us more of a financial cushion. When the atmospheric rivers we have been experiencing for the last 2 months subside, we will have a perc test conducted to determine if the lot is sellable.
